Define Workbook And Worksheet
A workbook can contain one or more different worksheets that can be accessed through the tabs at the bottom of the worksheet your currently viewing. What's often most confusing is that a worksheet is synonymous with a spreadsheet. In other words, a spreadsheet and worksheet mean the same thing.

How to define this workbook and active workbook
Set WSR = WBN Worksheets("Balance Sheet") After defining the variables, it becomes simpler to refer to cells in another workbook or worksheet. You can refer to cells in any worksheet without activating the worksheet or workbook, provided the workbook is open in the current Excel session.

5: Reference workbooks by index. The first workbook opened has an index value of 1, the second workbook opened has an index value of 2, and so on. Index values pose a special problem because they change when you delete a Workbook object from the collection; index values slip down a notch, accordingly.

A worksheet is a single set of the page where data is being entered while a workbook is an entity where multiple worksheets can be added to access the data. The main benefit of a workbook is that many worksheets can be used at the same time while using a separate worksheet for different tasks can become problematic.
