This engine, first unveiled in the Mondeo's North American cousin, the Ford Contour, is characterized by its smooth operation, chain-driven camshafts, and additional butterflies in the lower inlet to close off the inlet path to one valve, giving better torque at low engine speeds, this was vacuum operated on the Mk1 and electronically controlled on the Mk2.

It has 3.0 L (2967 cc) of displacement and produces between 200 hp (149 kW) and 240 hp (179 kW). The same engine is used by the Jaguar S-Type, Lincoln LS, Mazda MPV, Mazda6, Mondeo ST220 and many other Ford vehicles. It is essentially a bored-out (to 88.9 mm) Duratec 25 and is built in Ford's Cleveland Engine #2 plant.

In May 2009, a recall was issued for 730 Ford MA Mondeo vehicles fitted with 2.0-litre turbo-diesel engines. In these vehicles, the supply of vacuum to the brake booster could be interrupted – this could result in a hard brake pedal and increased stopping distances (PRA 2009/10807).

However, efficient 'crankcase breathing' is an equally important function of any engine whether Ford or not. Even in a new engine, the combustion pressure will inevitably pass the piston rings into the crankcase. If an engine's breathing system should become blocked or restricted, the crankcase will pressurise causing any one or more of the following problems:

Mondeo Ventilation problem - Dave N The vacuum feed to the distribution switch is the black hose, so check if you have vacuum here first. If not, go back to the accumulator which is a round black sphere about 4" diameter sat in the engine bay somewhere (should be easy to see), from there follow the vac pipe back to the inlet manifold.

The Ford Mondeo is a large family car manufactured by Ford since 1993. The first Ford declared a "world car", the Mondeo was intended to consolidate several Ford model lines worldwide (the European Ford Sierra, the Ford Telstar in Asia and Australia, and the Ford Tempo/Mercury Topaz of North America).The Mondeo nameplate is derived from Latin mundus, meaning "world".
