Guidelines for Developing a Rubric. On the basis of the purpose of the task, determine the number of points to be used for the rubric (example: 4-point scale or 6-point scale). Starting with the desired performance, determine the description for each score remembering to use the importance of each element of the task or performance to determine the score or level of the rubric.
